

YAKUTIA AIRLINES – FACT SHEET

ABOUT: Founded in 2002, **Yakutia Airlines** is a regional Russian airline headquartered in the central Siberian city of Yakutsk. The company is owned by the Russian Republic of Sakha. **Yakutia Airlines** operates scheduled passenger service to cities in Russia, Europe, Central Asia and East Asia, and will initiate service to the US in the summer of 2012.

HUBS: Yakutsk, Moscow (Vnukovo), Krasnodar

DOMESTIC DESTINATIONS: 36 cities including Moscow, Vladivostok, Khabarovsk, Irkutsk, Sochi, Krasnodar, St. Petersburg.

INTERNATIONAL ROUTES: Anchorage, Barcelona, Fergana, Hanover, Harbin, Dresden, Dushanbe, Palma de Mallorca, Prague, Qinhuangdao, Rimini, Seoul, Tashkent, Tokyo, Weihai.

FLEET: Yakutia Airlines operates a fleet of more than 30 modern aircraft, including Boeing 737-700, 737-800 and 757-200 aircraft and Russian AN-140 aircraft (52 passengers). It plans to expand its fleet with Bombardier Dash-8 Q300 aircraft in the near future.

AWARDS: In 2011, nominated for the prestigious "Wings of Russia" prize in the category "Russian Regional Airline of the Year."

PASSENGERS: 80,000 passengers carried per month.

EMPLOYEES: 1,400.
